A prayer for Palm Sunday: 'King Jesus, we welcome you and rejoice in you on this Palm Sunday. No other king could vanquish warhorses and warriors, riding on the foal of a donkey. No other king could break the battle bow and backbone of warfare by the brokenness of the cross. Lord Jesus, you are that King – the King of Glory, the Prince of Peace! Great is our rejoicing, because great is the salvation you bring! Thank you, Lord Jesus. Amen.'

As Good Friday approaches this week, let's pray that we will be deeply grateful for the cross. Let's thank Jesus for enduring such physical agony, emotional suffering and, above all, the spiritual anguish of separation from the Father as he gave his life to save us from the judgment on sin that would otherwise come our way.

Give success to the many Christian and other projects across the world providing a safe home, education, healthcare and other help. Amen.'
