

Prayer Points and Information

Continue to pray for strength and restoration for those who are suffering with ill-health or undergoing treatment.

Give thanks for Christian students, teachers, lecturers and others involved in higher education, where the prevailing attitude is often dismissive of those with a biblical faith. Pray that they will stand firm and speak out about the truth and grace of Christ.

Christians in Ukraine are asking that we join them in praying for an end to the current conflict, for wisdom for government and political forces so the crisis can be resolved peacefully, and for many Ukrainian people to come to Christ through this time.

Pray for the work of ROPE in Kenya. Praise God for the positive response, perception and good will for the Mercy and Justice work carried out by the communities, and pray for the implementation of the new constitution in the country.

Pray for the work of BMS World Mission in Lebanon and Israel/Palestine: (1) for Rupen Das, heading up the Community Development and Relief sector of the Lebanese Society for Educational and Social Development, coordinating a multi-faceted humanitarian response to the Syrian crisis; (2) for Arthur and Louise Brown at the Arab Baptist Theological Seminary, with students from across the Arab-Muslim world; (3) for Musalaha, promoting reconciliation between Israelis and Palestinians.
